To download the Madison Credit Union mobile app, follow these instructions:

Go into the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play Store (Android) and search for "Madison Credit Union".

Select the "Madison Credit Union" App and Click "Free" and then "Install"



Once installed, you can log-in using your account number/username, password, and security question or set up the following alternative ways to access your account:

- Face recognition
- Voice recognition
- PIN (4 digits)
- Fingerprint

Annual Shred Fest

Last year we shredded 6,260 pounds of paper. We also collected over \$300 and 78 pounds of food which was donated to River Food Pantry. Our goal is to exceed those numbers this year!



Our shred event is FREE and open to the public. This is a convenient opportunity to safely and securely dispose of paperwork that contains personal information. Pellitteri's Data Destruction Division will be on hand to immediately shred your old documents.

- Each person is allowed to bring up to three boxes or 3 bags of paper products.
- Rubber bands, staples, and paperclips are OK
- No plastic or plastic bags
- No three-ring binders, hanging file folders, CDs, floppy disks, tapes, credit cards, etc.
