Monitor your accounts. Monitor account activity by looking specifically for unknown purchases *or* credits and new Bill Pay or Pay Anyone activity. You can set up account alerts in the mobile app or online banking to help track activity.

Turn your debit card off. Go to the MCU Mobile app, click 'More' then 'Debit Card Controls'.

THERE'S A SPOT OPENING ON THE MCU BOARD

Have a say in how your credit union is run. Elected for three-year terms, MCU board members help set the general direction of the credit union and oversee management in the operations of MCU. The board is responsible for the general oversight and final decision-making over the affairs, funds and records of MCU in accordance with the Articles and Bylaws of the Credit Union.

A Board Member must have a certain base level of financial skills, consistent with the size and complexity of the credit union. If they do not have these skills when elected or appointed, MCU will make the appropriate financial training available to the Board member to be completed within six months of election.

What it entails:

- Monthly Board Meetings to discuss MCU's financials, the direction of the CU and new products and services.
- · Attendance at Annual Meeting.
- Annual Planning Session: normally a half day planning session on a Friday afternoon in the fall or spring; or a 2hr session following a Board Meeting.
- Possible other assigned committee meetings: dependent on the specific committee.

Qualifications:

- · Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be an MCU member for at least twelve (12) months and in good standing.
- Must be bondable by MCU's Fidelity Bond Company.
- Must authorize a background check and a credit check for security purposes.
