



Madison Credit Union will award one scholarship of \$1000 to a new or returning student who plans to attend a higher education institution in the fall of 2025.

To be eligible, students must:

- Be a member in good standing of Madison Credit Union for at least 6 months from the application deadline
- Have activity on their Madison Credit Union account within the prior 2 months from application deadline
- Be accepted to an accredited higher education institution
- Be eligible for graduation at the end of the 2024-2025 school year or have already graduated high school
- Have a total cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

MCU employees, Board members, and their families are not eligible. Previous scholarship winners are ineligible.

Applicant must submit:

- Completed application form
- Current transcript or grade report
- One letter of recommendation (teacher, employer, mentor, etc.)
- Acceptance letter from an accredited continued learning institution or class schedule for an accredited continued learning institution

Deadline:

The completed application plus a copy of transcripts or grade report, copy of acceptance letter or class schedule, and one letter of recommendation must be received by Friday, July 10th, 2025.

Awarding of Scholarship:

Applicants will be evaluated on their community service and volunteer work, extracurricular activities, short answer questions, and GPA. Decisions will be made by the Madison Credit Union Board of Directors in a blind application process by July 25th, 2025.
